



of businesses are unsure or unable to pay their property taxes by September 30, 2020



of businesses anticipate a cash shortfall of at least \$10,000 over the next 30 days



of businesses indicated they can survive 1-3 months in the current context without additional support



of businesses need to make at least 76% of typical sales to make it worthwhile to remain open through the summer




of businesses did not meet the criteria required to access the Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy Biggest concerns as we reopen the economy:
