Economic Indicators Q1 2024



Permit values for Q1 2024 in Lethbridge total \$114 Million.
Residential values sit at \$68.4 Million during this time period, up more than double compared to the same time last year.



There have been 138 housing starts in Lethbridge during the first 3 months of 2024. Multi-unit housing accounts for 71% of this number with 98 starts this year.



The unemployment rate in the Lethbridge CMA at the end of Q1 2024, up from 4.8% at the same time in 2023.



The participation rate in the Lethbridge CMA at the end of Q1 2024, this is a gain of 4.5% from the same time in 2023.



The value of all **exports** from the Lethbridge CMA in 2023 was **\$2.223 Billion**, up **3.1%** when compared to the 2022 figure.
